Read John 4:11-15.

Jesus makes a promise, a claim. What is it?

Read John 4:16-20.

Explain what Jesus is doing in verses 17-18.

Explain what the woman is doing in verses 19-20.

Read John 4:21-26.

What coming time is Jesus talking about?

“Salvation is from the Jews.” How so?

What do you think it means to worship *in spirit and in truth*?

What gospel does Jesus speak to the woman?

Read John 4:27-38.

What did Jesus want his disciples to see?

Read John 4:39-42.

The woman became an evangelist. Explain that.

What do you find significant about verses 41-42?

Who evangelized to you?

What approach to individual evangelism have you found beneficial?
