Read Matthew 4:23-25

Why is the order of things in verse 23 significant?

Note the places where people came from to see Jesus.

Read Matthew 8:14-17.

What lessons do you learn from Jesus' miracle in verses 14-15?

Explain the importance of the Isaiah quote in verse 17.

What lessons does any of Jesus' healing miracles teach you?

Each healing miracle is also unique. Each miracle teaches us specific lessons.

Read Matthew 8:1-4.

What does this miracle teach you about Jesus?

Read Matthew 8:5-13.

What astonished Jesus about the centurion's faith?

Read Mark 7:31-37.

Observe the way Jesus dealt with this man. What do you learn about Jesus from that?

What effect did this miracle have on the people?

Read Mark 8:22-26.

What is unique about this miracle, and why do you think Jesus did it that way?

Why do you think Jesus sometimes told people he healed not to tell about it?

Read Luke 5:17-26.

Why did Jesus heal this man?

Read Luke 17:11-19.

What lesson do you learn from this miracle?

Read John 4:46-53.

“Unless you people see miraculous signs and wonders, you will never believe.”

What about you?

Why do you think Jesus did the miracle the way he did it?

Presumably, what eventually happened to all the people whom Jesus healed?

Why does it matter to understand that?
