What kind of person is Paul questioning in verses 17-20?

What kind of questions is Paul asking that individual?

What devastating judgment does Paul place on that individual?

What kind of person is Paul addressing in verses 25-29?

Listen to Deuteronomy 10:14-17 and Jeremiah 4:4.

What is *circumcision of the heart*?
