According to verses 6-8, what do we need to remember about us?

According to verses 9-12, what do we need to remember about us?

What are some *disputable matters* (different opinions) that we might struggle with today?

How do Paul's reminders help us work through those struggles?

Let's read 14:13-23.

What does Paul tell us to be determined not to do?

Explain what Paul is saying in verse 14.

Look carefully through verses 15-18. List reasons why not to do what you know is okay to do.

What does Paul tell us to make every effort to pursue?

Whom does Paul call blessed?

How can you apply verse 23 to your own behaviors?
